# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgment that PCAV and added GREYOWEN rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCAV Gear Rules. Full-soled riding boots must be worn. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination.

Medical Armbands must be worn by all competitors in ALL phases.

Gear Check before riding each phase of the competition is required.

Competitor numbers must be worn – the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Body numbers will be available on the day.

Queries, protests, horse abuse rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.

More than one horse may be ridden subject to the conditions of PCAV Handbook of By-Laws multiple horse rules.

**Before Riding all competitors (and/or their guardian) must have signed the Waiver form and Participant Agreement and Declaration of Competency form.**

Officials and riders must not consume alcohol eight hours prior to the event.

Under-age drinking is not permitted. The full policy is available from the PCAV website or state office.

Camping is not available.

Entries close 10th of January or when classes are full

Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the organising committee, if numbers permit and will incur a penalty of \$5.00 per rider.

Horses must be at least four years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.

No phone entries will be accepted. No payment, no entry.

## DOGS or PETS ARE PROHIBITED WITHOUT EXCEPTION – INSTANT ELIMINATION

**Reservation of rights:** The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry without stating a reason.

**Disclaimer of liability: Neither the organising committee, property owners, PCAV, EA (EFA) or HRCav accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, owners, ground spectators or any other person on property.**

**Lungeing:** Lungeing is permitted in the warm-up area only.

**Uniform:** For dressage phase riders may wear; HRCav uniform or shirt, PCAV uniform or shirt, tie/stock, jacket, jodhpurs (white, cream, beige, banana or oatmeal). Riders may jump in a polo shirt or jumper.

## EVENT CANCELLATION

The Event will not be cancelled. If the event is unable to be run on the day due to inclement weather, or for any other reason at the discretion of the organising committee, refunds will be given to all riders who paid before the closing date.

# GREYOWEN RULES

PCAV Horse Trials rules are to be followed; including dressage tests, showjumping widths and heights, and cross country fence widths and heights; unless otherwise stated below:

**If not graded by PCAV or HRCVA you MUST be level assessed by Kim Owen prior to the event.**

Fall of horse or rider means elimination. If a rider has 3 refusals or run-outs at an individual jump they are eliminated. They may jump one obstacle on their way off the course at discretion of the jump judge.

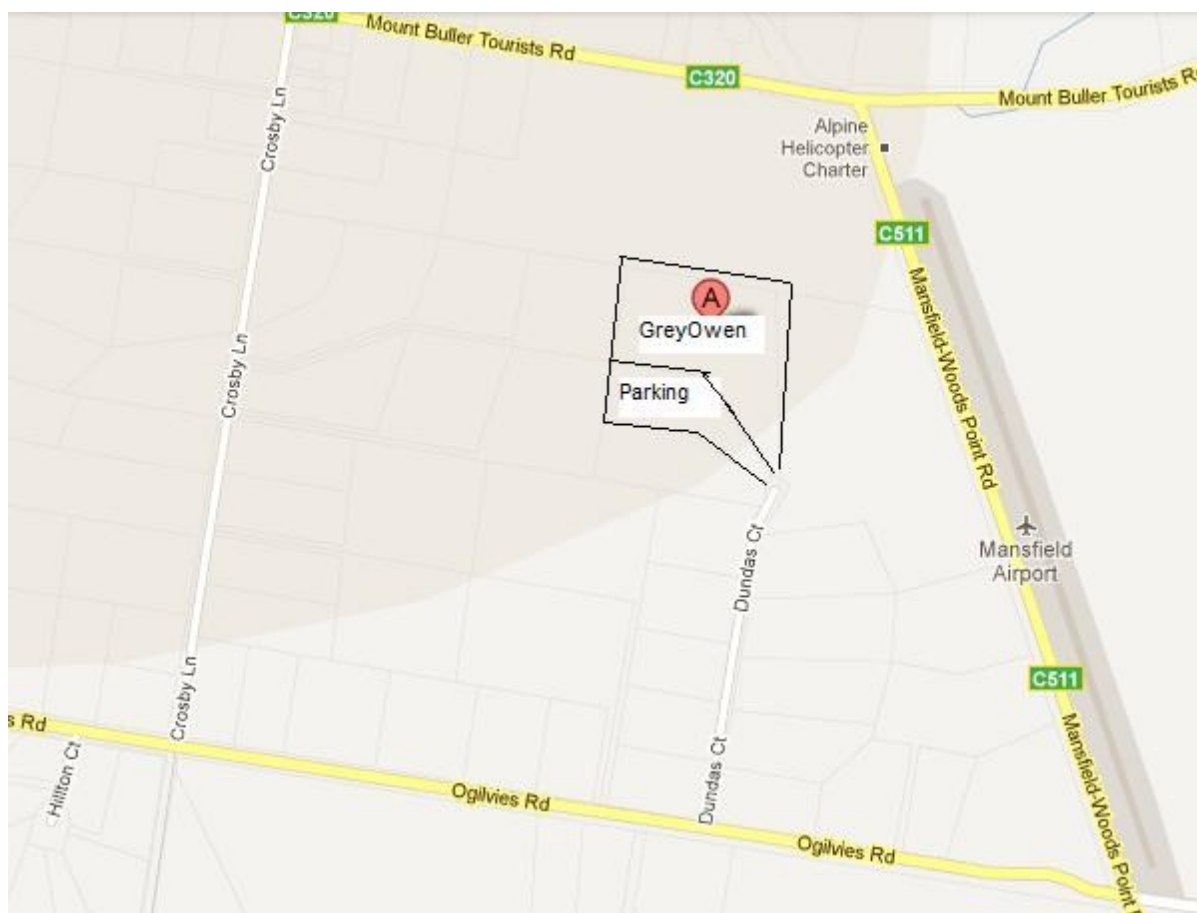
If a horse and rider combination is assessed at a higher dressage level to their jumping a 5 point penalty will apply and they must ride at their jumping level.

If riders meet other horses on the cross country ride left hand to left hand.

The cross country course will be open to for hire to entrants @ a discounted rate of \$5 per hour per rider up until 1 week prior to the event. After presentations it will be available for supervised training.

## **Directions:**

Follow Mt Buller Road and take the first turn on the right after the BP Service Station (Crosby Lane). Continue to the end and turn left into Ogilvies Road. Continue approximately 1km and at the top of the rise turn left into Dundas Court. We are at the end of Dundas Court. Parking is to be on the land next door (thank you to the Bertalli's).



# Waiver

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and **I voluntarily PARTICIPATE** at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the **CANCELLATION** of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst participating in the sport where this is required under the relevant PCAV or HRCVA rules and regulations and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that whilst participating I wear a suitable helmet at all times where required under the relevant PCAV or HRCVA rules and regulations and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees and/or the property owner (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

## **Effect of this Document**

I have had sufficient opportunity to read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind.

I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Releasees, to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering injury or death.
